TRANSITION INTO YEAR 1

Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will be aware, your child will transfer into Year 1 in September 2021. Due to Covid-19, our usual transition plans have been amended again this year and we are sadly unable to welcome Parents/Carers into school to meet their child's new class teacher. We will however be ensuring that the children get opportunities to spend time in their new class with their new teacher. This letter will give you an outline of the transition events planned.

Your child's new class

During week beginning 28.6.2021, your child will receive a letter from their new class teacher introducing themselves. Once your child has received this letter, there will be a link to a video on our website which shows where each class door is together with a short welcome message from his/her new teacher under your child's class.

Transition events

Monday 5th July, Tuesday 6th July, Wednesday 7th July

Your child will spend the day in their new class with his/her new teacher. We will manage swaps to new classes internally so please drop your child off and collect him/her at their usual class entrance at the usual time.

Starting date and times in September 2021

Your child will start school on Thursday 2nd September 2021. We will continue to operate our one-way system, with parents arriving between 8.45am and 9am. Please bring your child to his/her class new entrance. Your child should be collected between 3pm and 3.15pm from the same place.

We will be emailing you a copy of our school brochure for 2021-2022 during week beginning 28.6.2021. Please ensure that we have an up to date email address for you.



School Uniform Reminder

Wearing school uniform has many benefits for children. Amongst other things it fosters a sense of belonging and also a sense of pride in their school.

Pupils are required to wear uniform from Nursery upwards. Our uniform consists of:

- ▶ Blue or white shirt/blouse/polo shirt
- ▶ Plain black or grey trousers (no stripes or logos. Jeans, jogging bottoms or leggings are not permitted)
- ▶ Plain black or grey skirt or blue gingham dress
- ▶ Royal blue or navy sweatshirt/cardigan
- ▶ Any sensible flat, sturdy shoes or trainers which are completely black (no logos)

School jumpers can be purchased by logging onto Tots2Teens <https://totstoteams.com/> whilst plain blue jumpers, trousers and polo shirts can be bought locally.

Your child will be provided with a bagged PE kit (shorts and t-shirt), parents are asked to provide plimsolls. PE kits will be sent home at the end of each half term to be washed and returned after the holiday. **Earrings are not permitted to be worn in school.**
