Year 1	Children will develop class charters with rules for their class and will further develop their understanding of the reasons for these rules. Children will continue to learn about different types of families and relationships and will broaden their understanding of different family structures. The children have learned about people's personal space and the importance of asking someone for consent before touching them. They will build on this knowledge, learning about safe touch and unsafe touch and private parts of the body. Children will continue to develop their resilience, empathy, self-awareness, positivity, excellence, communication, teamwork through Commando Joes Traditional Tales Mission		Children have learned about rules in school and the reasons for them. They will build upon this knowledge by extending this knowledge of rules outside school that apply to everyone and the reasons for them. The children have learned about rights and responsibilities inside school and with their family and friends. Children will learn about taking responsibility with money.
